

Celtic Contemplative Evening Worship Marks Ten Years!

On **Sunday, March 11, at 6:51 pm**, we gather for the last Celtic evening service of this 2011-2012 season. It is also the Sunday when we mark ten years of offering Celtic contemplative worship at Pilgrim. We'll mark this milestone on March 11 with a special "Cake and Ceilidh Celebration" following the Celtic service that night. In addition, on the prior **Sunday, March 4**, Pilgrim's morning worship services at **8:30 & 11 am** will be a Celtic communion liturgy, led by the Pilgrim Celtic ensemble that leads evening worship. Also on that day, the **9:45 am forum** will be a time of reflecting together about Celtic contemplative worship at Pilgrim over these ten years, a conversation led by Dick Hensold, our composer-in-residence, Suzanne Swanson, creator of the Celtic word sections, Pastor Carol Tomer, and more.
